THE NAHANNI RIVER - A Once-In-A-Lifetime Experience!

Each year Kilcoo Camp is proud to offer a very special opportunity to the oldest campers (14 years of age and up). As we have in years past, Kilcoo will continue our tripping program tradition by offering you a chance to partake in our revered month long canoe trip. If we have 9 “appropriate” campers, the Long Trip will consist of approximately 3 and 1/2 weeks canoeing and hiking along the world famous Nahanni River.

Located in the North West Territories, the Nahanni River is home to some of the most stunning scenery and wildlife Canada has to offer. “I’ve traveled many rivers but none of them compare to (The Nahanni River) in terms of beauty,” says Henry Madsen, a Nahanni River Adventure Guide. The Nahanni is not only recognized on a national scale but is renowned world wide for a number of features such as its meandering nature through the heart of multiple mountain ranges, the tufa mounds which are 50 foot mountains made from calcium deposits and the receding Virginia Falls (which are twice as high as Niagara Falls). It is for these reasons that the United Nations designated the Nahanni River as its first world heritage site.

The Nahanni River trip will enjoy a plethora of natural activities within the safety of a national park including rock water slides, hot springs, rapids, cave explorations and hiking trips to the summit of the Tolkienesque Cirque of the Unclimables, Sunblood Mountain, and ‘Pulpit Rock’. This trip also offers abundant possibilities in the geography of the river, the history of its inhabitants, and its current flora and fauna. The Nahanni River offers new sites to be discovered and non-stop entertainment on a daily basis.

Kilcoo Camp is offering you the opportunity to take part in something very few people in the world are privileged enough to experience. Whether you are an avid tripper or simply interested in what Canada has to offer, the Nahanni River trip has something to offer for everyone. We also WELCOME ANY GUYS INTERESTED IN BEING A 1st YEAR LIT TO SIGN UP...This would be part of the 1st year LIT program.

The cost of the trip will be approximately \$9,500. This cost includes everything and although it is expensive, it is far cheaper than if you were to do this trip on your own. We require a deposit of \$2,000 which we will hold (not cash) until we have 9 campers confirmed. At that time we will forward all the ‘details’. For this trip we have to have the group assembled by the start of December. Please don’t hesitate to call me if you have any questions.
